Key Responsibilities

Duties include the following, but are not limited to:

Role will center around a core deliverable project designed to utilize real world data from our programs to produce executable and/or analytical value to the organization

- Pick tops, pay intervals, and analyze data covering an area of defined land sections
- Create a suite of maps (structure, isopach, pay thickness, porosity, water saturation) to identify and quantify any resource that may be present
- Identify potential drilling locations if they seem prospective
- An end of summer presentation of findings will be a core deliverable of the work term

Additional responsibilities may include but are not limited to:

- Act as support to the development/exploit team and liaise with other departmental teams;
- Day-to-day well file reviews, data gathering and collection;
- Analyze data and deliver findings to the team;
- Evaluate and present additional projects once complete.
